

## NEW BUSINESS BLOCK IS SOUTH SIDE ASSET.



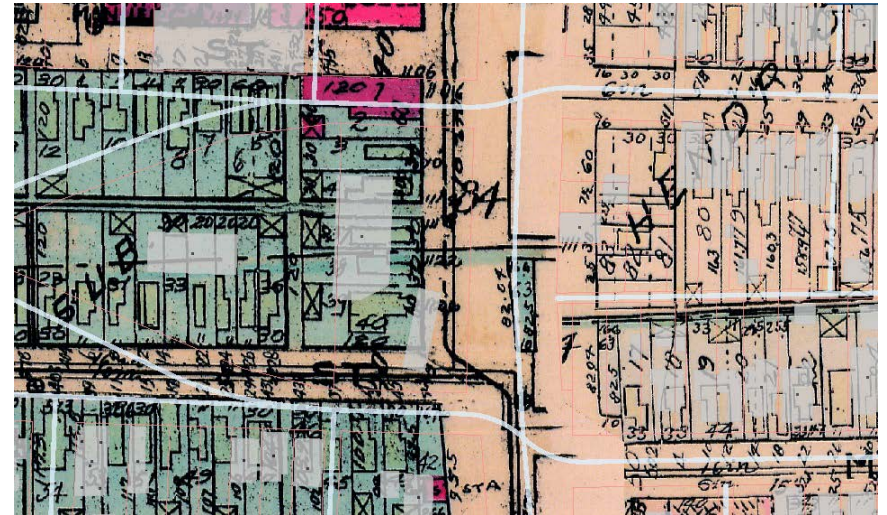
WOOMER BUILDING, VIRGINIA AVENUE AND GROVE STREET.

A creditable addition to the Westside has been made in the completion of the Woomer Building, on the southeast corner of Virginia avenue and Grove street, directly opposite the old-fashioned hardware store of C. Koenig, at No. 211. The building is a two-story brick structure, of "Hills Beach Pure Cherry Red" brick, and was erected for Harry Albert Clark, Westside, by the general contractor, Frank Davidson, from plans provided by the architect, Charles Wyckoff.

There are five modern store-rooms on the ground floor and fifteen office rooms on the second floor. The building is to be heated by a high-grade steam plant, and each room has the necessary system for cleaning walls and floors. Installed by John A. Wright, the heat was provided by the Hydraulic Powering Brick Company, and all the brick work was handled by the general brick contractor, John G. McManis. The extensive painting work was handled by John Bowers. This is a central location, in a trade center on the

Virginia avenue car line, and as the building is thoroughly equipped with hard-wood floors, electricity, and large glass-pane store fronts, it should be occupied readily. The accompanying illustration and plan give a fair idea of the arrangement. Large electric lights have been installed to illuminate the entire structure. Mr. Woomer will occupy the west room on Grove street, with a bank vault, and will conduct auxiliary operations. This new business center is one square north of the corner of Virginia avenue.



The Indiana State Historic Architectural and Archaeological Research Database (SHAARD) of the Division of Historic Preservation and Archaeology (DHPA) allows users to search information on known historic resources throughout Indiana. The data contained in SHAARD was collected from previously conducted cultural resource inventories, National and State Registers listings, research projects, and cultural resource management project reports.

SHAARD includes data from the IHSSI (County Survey Program), the Indiana Cemetery and Burial Ground Registry, historic bridges, properties listed in the National Register of Historic Places, properties listed in the Indiana Register of Historic Sites and Structures, and historic theaters in Indiana. Access to archaeological site locations and information is restricted.

The quality of the data varies with the completeness and precision of the original records and may be out-of-date. In addition, there are over 250,000 paper records from past surveys located in the office. Not all data is yet inputted into SHAARD. More information is being entered daily. Absence of data does not necessarily indicate the absence of resources.

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The Official Federal Land Records Site

Welcome to the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), General Land Office (GLO) Records Automation web site. We provide live access to Federal land conveyance records for the Public Land States, including image access to more than five million Federal land title records issued between 1788 and the present. We also have images of survey plats and field notes, land status records, and control document index records. Due to organization of documents in the GLO collection, this site **does not** currently contain every Federal title record issued for the Public Land States.

**Land Patents**

**Federal Land Patents** offer researchers a source of information on the initial transfer of land titles from the Federal government to individuals. In addition to verifying title transfer, this information will allow the researcher to associate an individual (Patentee, Assignee, Warrantee, Widow, or Heir) with a specific location (Legal Land Description) and time (Issue Date). We have a variety of Land Patents on our site, including Cash Entry, Homestead and Military Warrant patents.

**Survey Plats and Field Notes**

**Survey plats** are part of the official record of a cadastral survey. Surveying is the art and science of measuring the land to locate the limits of an owner's interest thereon. A cadastral survey is a survey which creates, marks, defines, retraces or re-establishes the boundaries and subdivisions of Federal Lands of the United States. The survey plat is the graphic drawing of the boundaries involved with a particular survey project, and contains the official acreage to be used in the legal description.

**Field notes** are the narrative record of the cadastral survey. They are written in tabular format and contain the detailed descriptions of entire survey process including the

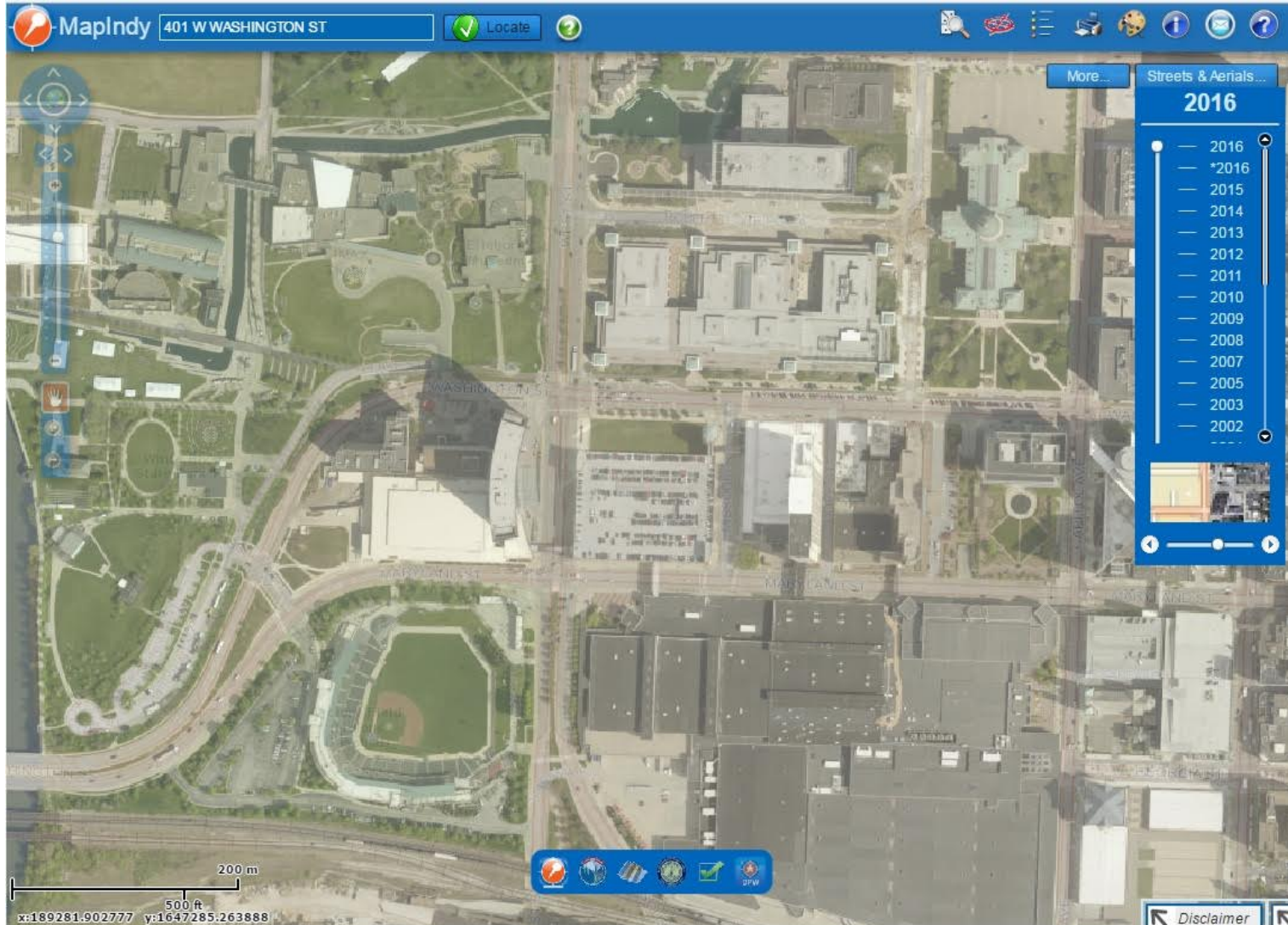
